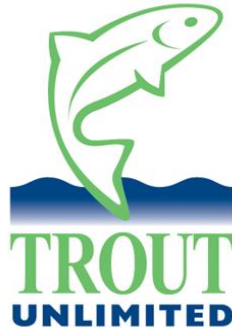

3. National TU has rewritten their By-laws and has given all of the Chapters one year to adopt them. Some of the changes are minor but important. One being, "No Chapter or chapter officer, director or member may transfer, sell, barter or lease to any person or entity the membership list or the names, addresses, contact information or any personal information of the member". This is a good thing and I'm glad I've guarded our email list so well. Another important point is "No officer shall serve more than three (3) consecutive one-year terms". This should make our elections quite interesting.

I will have complete copies of the proposed changes available at the October meeting.
